## **ORDINANCE NO. 2025 - 056**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE KENT FIRE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR A STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND FEMA, AND TO ACCEPT ANY GRANT, IF AWARDED, WITH CORRESPONDING APPROPRIATIONS OF FUNDS WHICH PROVIDES FUNDING FOR THREE (3) FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC POSITIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the Kent Fire Department would like to apply for a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant through the Department of Homeland Security and FEMA; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant will provide funding for three (3) Firefighter/Paramedic positions over a three (3) year period, such as salaries, benefits, etc; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost sharing portion is \$25,000 in years 1 and 2; and cost sharing portion is \$65,000 in year 3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Kent, Portage County, Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Kent City Council authorizes the Kent Fire Department to apply for a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) grant through the Department of Homeland Security and FEMA.

**SECTION 2.** That the Kent City Council hereby approves the City's acceptance of any such grant, if awarded to the City, with corresponding appropriations for its use.

**SECTION 3.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
