Information Items

1. Kent Police Statistics

Chief Shearer has provided a copy of the police statistics report for June. The month to date calls for service are up 3% (by 50 calls); traffic citations are up 64% (by 57 tickets); accident incidents are down 2 calls at 34 incidents for the month and serious crimes are up by 1 call, at 2 incidents when compared to 1 in June of 2024. 2. Monthly Permit and Zoning Reports

Bridget Susel has enclosed copies of the monthly zoning and permit violations report for June 2026. Permit revenues were \$10,472.10 for the month with the most permits being issued for HVAC (20 permits). There were 94 code enforcement items for the month. (attachment)
