## Information Items

### 1. Monthly Permit and Zoning Reports

Bridget Susel has enclosed copies of the monthly zoning and permit violations report for June 2025. Permit revenues were \$10,928.24 for the month with the most permits being issued for Electrical and HVAC (18 permits each). There were 116 code enforcement items for the month. (attachment)

### 2. Fire Incident Reports

Chief Samels has provided a copy of the fire and emergency medical services reports for June 2025. The MTD calls for fire service are up 16.7% (at 140 calls) compared with 2024. Calls for fire mutual aid assistance received MTD is unchanged at 1 call for the month in 2025 as compared to 2024; and EMS responses are up 14.6% (by 44 calls) for 2024, compared to MTD 2024.
