New Business Activity

- BIBIBOP Asian Grill opened on May 22nd in the former Chipotle space at 429 East Main Street. A ribbon cutting was held the same day. BIBIBOP offers healthy Asian bowls and salads, with a format similar to Chipotle with Korean influences and flavors.

- Gigi's Ristorante and Market, a new Italian restaurant concept from the Chagrin Falls based Taproot Hospitality Group, leased the former Bricco space in College Town Kent. Renovations of the property are underway, with an anticipated opening in the winter. Gigi's will offer Italian cuisine at an affordable price point, as well as retail wine, cheese, and pre-made meal options from it's Market.
- Kent Automation, the machine shop at 449 Dodge Street, sold earlier this year. The new owner relocated from Columbus to run the business. All employees were retained, and there are plans for future growth.
- The owner of Sue Nelson Designs Ltd, at 156 South Water Street, is retiring. A portion of the building has been leased to For The Birds And More, a retail oddity shop that offers artistic products and classes, which is relocating from Ravenna.
- 124 South Water Street, previously Firefly Hookah Bar, has sold. The new owner plans to convert the property into an event center.
- Enterprise Rent-A-Car purchased the former Longhitanos at 1225 West Main Street. Currently leasing space across the street, Enterprise plans on consolidating its Kent and Hudson location into one at 1225 West Main Street after renovations are complete.
- Teed Off Golf, a new golf simulator business concept, has signed a lease for the former Boost Mobile space in the Marc's Plaza at 1600 South Water Street. The business will have two golf simulator bays, and a winter opening is anticipated.
- Sheetz, at 600 North Mantua Street, is being reconstructed to align with a new layout.

- Aarons Rent To Own, located at 1850 State Route 59 in the Franklin-Kent JEDD, has closed. The building has been sold to Flynn's Tire and Auto Service, which plans to relocate from its current location across the street at 1897 SR 59.
- Brimfield Town Centre Plaza, located at 4064 State Route 43, sold at auction. The new owner has been making updates to attract new tenants. Both Wing Warehouse, and The Ornament Factory, have signed leases.
